## **Local Student Among 30 Global Dover Scholarship Recipients**

Daughter of Roseville-based CPC Employee

**Roseville, Minn. – May 12, 2022** – A Minnesota student and child of a <u>CPC (Colder Products Company)</u> employee is among 30 recipients worldwide of scholarships from the Dover Scholars Program. Winners represent both high school seniors and current college students and may receive up to \$12,000 in scholarship support over the four years of their undergraduate education.

Allison is honored to be chosen for the scholarship because "it means that I'm one step closer to my goal of becoming an engineer." She plans to major in Biomedical Engineering at the University of Iowa. "The financial assistance will open up many opportunities for me to get involved in college next year."

Allison's dad, David, added, "I am very appreciative to work for a company that supports their employees in many different ways. The Dover scholarship demonstrates this support by investing in the future of our children."

Now in its eleventh year, the Dover Scholars Program recently expanded to reach more children of full-time employees, along with granting larger awards. Over the years, the program has awarded 373 scholarships, providing approximately \$2.6 million in financial support to deserving students.

CPC also offers a separate scholarship program for all employees' dependents who are pursuing education after high school. Students attending a two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school are eligible for \$1,200 annually during their continued enrollment in an accredited institution.
